

After my husband Tres passed away in 2015, the last thing I felt like doing was raising money for a disease that had turned my life upside down. Celebrating was the last thing I wanted to do.

One day during a spin class a thought came to me - I no longer resented the disease that took my husband's life, I wanted to make a difference. I love to spin and asked my friends at Grit Cycle if they would host a ride as a fundraiser on my birthday for family and friends.

In lieu of birthday gifts, I requested that donations be made to the Amyloidosis Foundation. In 2016 we sold out the ride and raised over \$11,000. In 2017 we were able to raise over \$18,000!
